On June 18, 2024, Syra Health Corp. (the “Company”) held its Annual Meeting of Stockholders (the “Annual Meeting”). A total of 15,222,830 shares of common stock (including 833,334 shares of Class B common stock with each share of Class B common stock having 16.5 votes per share) , constituting a quorum, were represented in person or by valid proxies at the Annual Meeting. The final results for each of the matters submitted to a vote of stockholders at the Annual Meeting, as set forth in the Definitive Proxy Statement, filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on April 24, 2024 are as follows:

Proposal 1. All of the eight (8) nominees for director were elected to serve until the 2025 Annual Meeting of Stockholders or until their respective successors have been duly elected and qualified, or until such director’s earlier resignation, removal or death.
